

**KEHILA KEDOSHA JANINA**


KEHILA KEDOSHA JANINA WAS BUILT IN 1902 BY CELESTINO BRUNO, AND FROM HIS FATHER'S DESIGN AND AS THE ONLY REMAINING SYNAGOGUE IN THE BRITISH MUSEUM, THE BRICK-FACED BUILDING IS SURROUNDED WITH SYMBOLIC JEWELRY ORNAMENTS, INCLUDING A PRISM REFLECTOR ON THE TOP CORNER, AND A STAR OF DAVID, EMBLEMED BY THE 1000th ANNUARY OF THE BIRTH OF DAVID, EMBLEMED BY KASHIYUKI, ENOAH'S CALLING, A DESCENDANT OF ONE OF THE TRIBES OF ISRAEL, KEHILA KEDOSHA JANINA IS THE ONLY ONE OF AN OTHER SYNAGOGUE, PRESERVING THE HISTORICAL LIBRARY AND IN THE MIDDLE OF THE 19th CENTURY.



The Plaka Bridge, over Arachthos River, was the largest stone one-arch bridge in Greece and the Balkans, and the third largest one-arch stone bridge in Europe. Its stone arch measured 40 meters and curved majestically over the river, 21 meters above the water. 1866
